

# Wax casting wax for Jewellery

Casting wax for jewellery is specifically designed as a casting wax for small jewellery.

#### Description

Our Jewellery wax is especially designed for casting small Jewellery such as rings, pendants and earrings. The wax is very well suited for casting shapes in silicone. This was quickly hardens so you do not lose to much time. The wax is flexible enough to get out of a flexible mould without damaging the wax part.

### **Technical data**

Melting point	75 ° C
Ideal processing temperature	66-75 ° C
Color	Blue

#### processing

The wax is melted at a temperature of 75 °C and poured into an open mold. The professional caster will do so under pressure or vacuum to prevent air bubbles. The wax model is used in the lost wax method in cuvettes.

#### **Special instructions**

Avoid overheating (above  $100\,^{\circ}$ C) the wax at all times. When overheated the wax can be damaged altering properties.

#### packing

The Jewellery wax is delivered in the form of small pellets the size of a pea and is packaged in bags of 1 kg.

### Durability

At least 5 years.

#### safety

Prevent skin contact with the molten (liquid) wax and avoid inhalation of gases / vapors.
