Gilding Wax

This gives a nice metallic look to a work of art or body cast. If you are new to these products, we recommend that you practice before starting with the real object!

Description:

Gilding Wax turns a black background into a very nice metallic color. With this you can add an old metal effect to an image / object. We have specially selected this gilding wax for use with porcelain plaster or acrylic resin, but it is also suitable for wood, cardboard, glass, metal, etc.

Bodycasting Primer Black:

The black primer gives more contrast, so that a gilding wax often comes into its own.

Use the primer moderately to avoid a dark surface. If desired, the primer can be mixed with a little water / wet brush on a plate before it is applied to the picture with a brush. That way you get a thinner and more metered stake and better retention of detail. Let the primer dry at room temperature for an hour before proceeding.

Processing of gilding wax:

The contents of the can are ready to use immediately. Put a very small amount on the tip of your finger. Then wipe your finger on a smooth surface, leaving a very thin layer on your fingertip. Then rub your object gently in circular motions. If some more is peeling off, increase the pressure or add some gilding wax. (where you wiped your finger from) Work in thin layers for the best effect. This is usually three layers.

If you plan to use multiple colors together, do not apply other colors until the first layer has dried or has stopped transferring. Working with Gilding Wax is not difficult, but you have to deal with it first.

When you're done, let it harden for about 5 minutes. Now the best is yet to come! Grab a handkerchie or tissue paper and polish it up!

Durability:

If the gilding wax is stored in closed packaging, cool, dry and frost-free, the shelf life is 1-2 years.

Safety requirements

Keep out of reach of children.

Flammable: Keep container away from sources of heat, sparks and open flames.

Do not take orally.

In the event of splashes or eye contact: rinse thoroughly with clean, soft water for 15 minutes with the eyelids open.
